THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CAMERON:

Section 1. That the said Maurice Goza Jr. is hereby declared to be the duly elected Council Member, Ward #1 of the City of Cameron, Texas; and that the said Kyle Deal is hereby declared to be the duly elected Council Member, Ward #3 of the City of Cameron, Texas; and that the said Virgie Hardeman is hereby declared to be the duly elected Council Member, Ward #5 of the City of Cameron, Texas; and that the said Melissa Williams is hereby declared to be the duly election Council Member At Large of the City of Cameron, Texas, all to fill their terms of their respective officers for the two years ending in the month of May 2021.

City Secretary Amy Harris administered the Oath of Office to the newly elected Council Members: Melissa Williams, Council Member At-Large, Maurice Goza, Jr., Council Member Ward 1 and Virgie Hardeman, Council Member Ward 5.
