CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL ELECTION OF OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, TEXAS, HELD ON THE FIFTH DAY OF MAY 2018.

WHEREAS, at the special meeting of the City Council of Cameron, Texas, held on the 14th day of May, 2018, there came to be considered the returns of the annual General Election of officers and the Special Election of officers of the City of Cameron, Texas, heretofore held on the 5th day of May, 2018, and:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CAMERON:

Section 1. That the said Robert Schiller is hereby declared to be the duly elected Council Member, Ward #2 of the City of Cameron, Texas; and that the said Lekethia "KeKe" Sims hereby declared to be the duly elected Council Member, Ward #4 of the City of Cameron, Texas; and that the said Connie Anderle is hereby declared to be the duly elected Mayor of the City of Cameron, Texas, all to fill their terms of their respective officers for the two years ending in the month of May 2020.

Section 2. That the said Kyle Deal is hereby declared to be the duly elected Council Member, Ward #3 of the City of Cameron, Texas to fill the unexpired term of her respective office for one year ending in the month of May 2019.

Mayor Anderle recognized Council Member Mondrik for 28 years of service.

There being no further business for the Council to consider, Council Member Mondrik moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:42 p.m. Council Member Schiller seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
