A City Council workshop and regular meeting was held on the above date in the City Council Chamber, 100 South Houston Avenue with all officers and members present except City Manager JRhett Parker and City Secretary Amy Harris. Amy appointed Paula Woods to assist with the minutes.

Mayor Anderle called the regular meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Street Supervisor Craig Arnold offered the invocation.

Council Member Deal led the pledge of allegiance.

There were no citizen's comments at this time.

Council Member Schiller moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of May 21, 2018. Council Member Deal seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Schiller moved to approve the expenditures of May 19, 2018 to June 1, 2018. Council Member Deal seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
