

City Council Regular Meeting
January 19, 2021

A City Council special meeting was held on the above date at The Yards of Cameron, 303 Adams Avenue, Cameron, Texas with all officers and members present except Mayor Harris and Council Member Fuchs.

Mayor Pro-Tem Hardeman called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council Member Goza offered the invocation.

Council Member Williams led the pledge of allegiance.

Council Member Sims entered at this time.

There were no citizen's comments at this time.

Council Member Deal moved to approve the minutes of the December 21, 2020 regular meeting. Council Member Williams seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Chantelle House, representing Soul Hawk Motorcycle Club, requested use of Ledbetter Park on April 23-25, 2021 for motorcycle rally. According to Ms. House, event insurance and security will be purchased should the event be approved. The rally will involve 50 to 200 people and will have protocols to follow for COVID-19. The President's of each club will enforce ruled for COVID-19 protocols. The event will have an admission fee to help raise money for charity.

Council Member Williams moved to approve use of the park and provide trash bins for the April 23-25, 2021 for the Soul Hawk Motorcycle Club. Council Member Goza seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Alan Hudson, representing Freese and Nichols presented the scope of work and fee proposal for the Little River Pump Station permitting.

Council Member Deal moved to table this item until the City Attorney had reviewed documents with Freese and Nichols attorney. Council Member Goza seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Street Supervisor Craig Arnold requested permission to spend an additional \$5,000 from the budgeted amount on a smooth drum roller from Anderson Machinery Austin, Inc.

Council Member Williams moved to approve the purchase as requested. Council Member Sims seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Deal moved to approve the expenditures for December 19, 2020 through January 15, 2021. Council Member Goza seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

There following expenditures exceeded \$25,000:

- Waste Connections \$33,939.28

Council Member Goza moved to table the December 2020 Financial Report. Council Member Deal seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
