

## Resolution No.2017-11-06-009

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Cameron finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Cameron that the Cameron Police Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Grant Program(BAGP) be operated for the 2018 calendar year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Cameron does not have to provide any matching funds for the said project; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Council of the City of Cameron agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division Funds, the City Council of the City of Cameron assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

**WHEREAS**, The City Council of the City of Cameron designates City Manager JRhett Parker as the grantee's authorized official and Sergeant Antony Maskunas as the grantee's project director. The authorized official is given the power to accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Cameron, Texas approve submission of the grant for the Cameron Police Department Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
